

big ask, big give How do you ask for a kidney?

If you need a kidney transplant, you may not know how to ask someone to consider donating their kidney to you. **Asking can feel as hard as giving.** Many people won't get a transplant simply because they don't know how to ask. public health education

The **NKFL** participates in statewide health fairs, screenings, seminars, lunch and learns, etc. to **educate** the public about kidney disease. Our main message focuses on the **main causes** of chronic kidney disease. Stepping Back Into Life

was designed to help individuals with chronic kidney disease (CKD) and dialysis or transplant patients to restore emotional health and psychosocial functioning after a trauma or disaster. SBIL was created to reduce the risk and impact of depression in patients with CKD or a kidney transplant by developing and maintaining social support.

your kidneys and youth

The NKFL created a health education program focused on the public youth (it is NOT an education program for kids with CKD, although those kids might find it helpful to share). The program aims to educate middle school age kids through video tutorials about healthy behaviors like good nutrition, hydration, and physical activity to prevent chronic diseases like diabetes, high blood pressure, and kidney disease later in life.

safe rides with uber health

Transportation is one of the most common barriers faced by low income communities in need of timely and necessary medical care. In **Louisiana**, there are over **16,000** individuals receiving life-saving dialysis treatments. **"Safe Rides with Uber Health"** ensures that Louisiana's kidney patients have safe and reliable transportation to and from dialysis.

Five Quick Kidney Disease Facts:

Every year, kidney disease kills more people than breast or prostate cancer.

Major risk factors for kidney disease include

diabetes, high blood pressure, family history of kidney failure and being age 60 or older.

Additional risk factors include kidney stones, smoking, obesity, cardiovascular disease and ethnicity of African American, Asian and Native Americans.

Kidney disease has no symptoms; it can go undetected until it is very advanced.

(Protein in the urine is the earliest marker of kidney damage. Simple urine and annual blood tests can detect how well the kidneys are functioning).

Men with kidney disease are **more likely** than

women to progress to kidney failure.

Black Americans are three times more likely to experience kidney failure and Hispanics are 1 ½ times.

There are 122,000 Americans – close to 1,900 are

Louisianans – currently on the waiting list for an organ transplant.

Of those, more than 100,000 need a kidney, yet fewer than 17,000 people receive one each year. On average, 12 people die everyday waiting for a kidney.



1 in 3 American adults is currently "at risk" for developing kidney disease.


